## SUNDAY ROUND 6– Sprints

7.15am	Riders Brief if required (Compulsory)
730am	Sighting lap
8.30 – 2.30pm	Racing commences
2.45pm	Presentations

### FORMAT:

- Saturday = X Country
- Sunday –Sprints (1 track)
- X Country J4, J3, J2, JG – 4hrs – J1, JJ, OJ 3 hrs racing
- Pit area will be a pull off shared area separate to the race line (Camping will be in a separate area)
- Track consists of Enduro X & natural terrain
- Sprints –Track consisting of Enduro X track, Enduro natural terrain
- 15 – 30 Sec rider intervals at the discretion of the CofC

### PITS AREA:

- The Pits area will be a separate pull off shared pits area from the race line. Refuelling, minor repairs and hydration/rest for the kids will be in this area. Major repairs, the riders can take their bikes back to their camp area.
- Riders will continue on the race line unless they wish to enter the Pits area, where they will exit the racetrack, travel at slow speed (1<sup>st</sup> gear pace, or as prescribed by the CofC on the day) into the Pits area to receive assistance. This area will be a shared area for all riders (No Camping) Once finished, the rider will then exit the Pits area and join back onto the racetrack.

### STARTS:

- Start will be Le Mans (rider off the bikes and behind on the ground) mass start in classes with a 1-minute gap between each class.

### TIMING:

- My laps electronic timing will be used through the event.

### RACE CLASSES:

- JEDS – As per Series Sup regs

### SIGN ON:

- Sign-on will be via electronic registration. All riders MUST have their hard copy MA license or the MA App electronic version. Download your MA app now through Apple or Android.
- **ALL RIDER MUST BRING SELF SCRUTINEER FORMS COMPLETED WITH THEM TO SIGN ON**
- The barcode will be scanned as your entry acknowledgement and signature. All juniors (under 18yrs) **MUST** be accompanied by their parents or guardians when registering for the event.

### SCRUTINEERING:

All bikes must be scrutineered by the self- scrutineering form and submitted prior to the race or as per Sup Regs. Random inspections will occur during the event by officials.

## ***FINAL INSTRUCTIONS – ROUND 5 & 6 MURPHYS CREEK***

### **WALKING OF TRACKS:**

All riders may walk the tests prior to any race however sighting laps will be provide prior to racing on the days. No push bikes are permitted on any part of the tracks.

### **CAMPING:**

- Camping will be available Friday & Saturday nights.
- Toilets & showers available onsite
- There is ok mobile phone coverage at the venue.

### **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS:**

Each rider/crew **MUST** supply a minimum 2KG Powder Fire Extinguisher at their refuelling/pit area.

### **HELMETS AND DOUBLING:**

Helmets **MUST** be worn at all times by any person on a motorcycle whilst at this venue. Doubling on motorcycles is **NOT** permitted ever.

### **REFUELING**

Enviromats must be used when replenishing any fluids, penalties will apply for non-compliance. Enviromats **MUST** be the minimum dimensions of the mat will be at least equal to the wheelbase of the motorcycle and of the width of the handlebars. Must be positioned under the bike so as to catch any fluid spilt. Refueling only in designated refueling area.

**All riders must dismount from the bike before refueling and engines must be stopped.**

### **CANTEEN:**

The local Club will be running the Canteen. EFTPOS will be available so please check out the menu attached.

### **RIDERS BRIEFING (COMPULSORY):**

All riders (parent or guardian if under 18years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, and any competitor not present maybe be penalized.

Riders Briefing is a NO SMOKING area.

### **PRESENTATION:**

Presentation ASAP after racing has ceased on the final day. We ask that all riders attend to support the events team, sponsors, landowners, and the riders.

### **TRANSPONDER HIRE:**

Transponders brackets can be hired or can be brought at the event through the timing team for \$10.00. Please have exact cash.

A reminder that if you have hired the transponder, you have entered an agreement and any damage and/or loss will incur a fee as required.

Please ensure you bring cable ties in order to secure your transponder & bracket to your motorcycle. If you lose it, you will incur a replacement fee.

### **MEDICAL:**

Medical will be provided by HEST Paramedical at the event 30 mins prior and after the event meeting. If you are injured or hurt prior or during the event, please come and see the team for assessment or clearance.
